Nixle – Nixle is a real-time, no cost, and secure automated information disseminating system that allows subscribers to stay abreast of activity involving the Oakboro Police Dept. and the Town of Oakboro. At Nixle you have the option of getting notified by email and or by text messages sent to your cell phone. Nixle can also send you photographs that we have posted to the site that might help us identify persons or property. Nixle also has the capability to call telephone numbers in any given area if there is a need to get information to the public during an emergency situation. Simply go to www.nixle.com and register using a physical Oakboro address. If you do not live in Oakboro but would like to sign up for Nixle, you can use the Oakboro Police Dept.'s address of 109 North Main Street.

Face Book – Face Book is a social networking website a person can subscribe to and communicate with friends, family, and organizations. Face Book access is by invitation only. Go to the Face Book website and register, and then search for Joe Lowder and request access. www.facebook.com

Twitter – Twitter is a social networking website that allows a person to post small tidbits of information. Go to the Twitter website and register and then search for OAKBOROPD. Here we post short messages about what is happening in Oakboro. www.twitter.com
