District Park Rules and Fees*

Park Rules in General

The Town of Oakboro Is Not Responsible for Accidents or Injuries

No Motorized Vehicles Beyond Parking Lot

No Alcohol, Drugs, or Weapons

All Pets Must Be on Leash

All Pet Excrement Must Be Picked Up

No Pets Allowed in Ball Field or Playground Area

No Golf Balls May Be Hit In The Park

No Hunting or Fishing

No Signs, Advertisements, Sales of Merchandise, or Solicitations Allowed in Park Except By Special Permit

No Amplified Sound, Music, Noise, or Voice Permitted Except by Special Permit

No Parking Except In Designated Areas

All Children Must Be Supervised By An Adult

No Profanity or Lewd Behavior Allowed

No Swimming, Wading, or Boating in Pond

No Walking on Ice When Pond Frozen

No Graffiti or Defacing of Property

No Open Flame

No Fireworks

No Gambling

No Disorderly Conduct or Threatening Language

No Amusement Rides, Tents, or Inflatable Apparatus Without Permit

All Garbage, Litter, and Food Stuffs Must Be Collected and Disposed of Prior to Departure from the Park

No Airplane, Flying Machine, Balloon, Parachute, or other Apparatus of Aviation are Allowed in the Park Without Special Permit. This Includes Radio-Controlled Airplanes, Helicopters, and Rockets.

No Activity Allowed That May Be Hazardous to Persons or Property

It Shall Be Unlawful to Interfere with any Park or Town Employee in the Performance of Their Duties

Any Violation of Park Rules or Regulations Will Result in Expulsion from The Park and Possible Elimination from Participation in Future Park Events

Playground (Tot Lot) Specific Rules

All Children Using Playground Equipment Must Be Supervised By An Adult

Picnic Shelter Specific Rules

District Park Rules and Fees*

Picnic Shelters May Be Rented & Reserved On A Daily Basis For A Fee and on a First Come, First Served Basis. A Cash Deposit is Required Before Rental

Users of Picnic Shelters Are Responsible For The Clean-up Of The Area

Nails and Staples are Prohibited from Use on Any Structure

The Town of Oakboro Is Not Responsible for Accidents or Injuries

Shelters- Pond/Playground Picnic Shelters-

\$40 to reserve for all Day

\$25 to reserve for ½ Day (Times are Dawn to 1pm and 1:30 to Dusk)

Forms: Signature Card for Park Use Rental

Barbequing

No Gas Grills Allowed in the Park

Charcoal Grills are Acceptable

Used Charcoal Must be Deposited in the Provided and Marked Receptacle

Concessions

The Concession Stand will be Contracted Out for Either a Flat Rate or a Percentage of the Profits.

No Bicycles, Skates, Skate Boards, or Scooters Allowed in the Concession Area

Horseshoe Pits

Replace Horseshoe Pit Stake Cover When Finished

Gazebo

No Sitting or Standing on Railing

No Bicycles, Skates, Skate Boards, or Scooters Allowed on Pier Walkway or Gazebo

Gazebo Reservation

No Charge

Amphitheater

Amplification is allowed by permit only.

Area is to be left clean of trash and debris upon completion of event.

Electricity is available upon Reservation of the venue.

Amphitheater Reservations*

Must complete Special Event Permit Application and provide proof of insurance in most cases.

For Profit Events- \$100- In town rate, \$150- Outside Town rates

All other Events- \$40 including Non-Profits (Local Churches and Schools and other Non-Profits may submit a request for no fee on Organization letterhead)

Forms: Signature Card for Park Use Rental, Special Event Permit, Noise Permit, Temporary Sign Permit if necessary.

Ball Field Fees* and Rules

No Metal Cleats Allowed

No Soft Toss Against Fencing Allowed

No Loaded or Altered Bats Allowed

No Profanity or Threatening Language

No Smoking on Ball Fields

No Spectators Allowed on Ball Field

No Bicycles, Skates, Skate Boards, or Scooters Allowed in the Ball Field Area

The Town of Oakboro Is Not Responsible for Accidents or Injuries

USSSA/NSA Entry Fee \$450.00 per Team Plus Sanction Fee – Cash or Money Order Up Front

Ball Fields*-

All responsible parties renting the field must agree to follow safety procedures.

Youth Games/Practice- \$0

Practice/Non-Profit/Benefits-Proof of insurance is required in most cases

Inside Town Rate- \$40 per field per day

Outside Town Rate- \$75 per field per day

League Tournaments- Proof of insurance required

\$150 per day per field non-sanctioned events

\$150 per day both fields sanctioned events

Forms: Signature Card for Park Use Rental, Special Event Permit, Safety Procedures, Noise Permit if necessary, Temporary Sign Permit if necessary, Ball Field Rental Contract if necessary.
