The Board of Commissioners met in an Organizational meeting that followed by regular meeting, and began with Town Clerk Whitney Mackey reading the abstract of votes provided by the Stanly County Board of Elections. Greater Oakboro Business Association President, Ryan Story, a Notary Public administered the Oaths of Office. Newly elected Mayor Danny Long took his oath of office with the assistance of Deacon Darryl Morton, followed by Commissioner Chris N.
